President's Report

2023-24 was another exciting year for ACTMMNA and the ACT Griffins. A number of significant milestones have been achieved, which have continued to take our programs from strength to strength. In a historic first for our association the ACT Griffins entered both a men's and mixed team into the open division at the 2024 Australian Championships. There has been a renewed focus on our youth program with the re-inclusion of the 17's to Nationals and the second year of our Griffins academy. We have grown in leaps and bounds and none of this would have been possible without the amazing group of volunteers that we have on our committee and in our programs. I would like to take this opportunity to say a huge thank you to everyone who has donated time whether small or large, it is the combined efforts that make this family what it is today.

It would also be remiss of me not to acknowledge another significant achievement for our Association. At our 2023 AGM, ACT Men's and Mixed Netball Association acknowledged our first Life Member Patrick Cronan. Life Membership in our constitution is to be voted on and awarded at the Annual General Meeting. Patrick was a driving force in establishing our association and helping it grow to where it is today. He was in the first ACT Griffins Men's team and a part of the Committee since 2016.

There have been significant personal achievements across our Griffins program highlighted in this report through Australian selection, All Star 7 and team awards. As an association we welcomed the Mark Kerr Cup back to the ACT, with 9 fantastic games played between the Griffins and NSW. We have grown our coaching and manager numbers and capacity and have increased our umpire representation at Nationals. Our Committee's policies and procedures continue to strengthen as do our relationships with AMMNA, member states and Netball ACT.

In the 2024 program year, the Committee took an important step to contract a Head Coach for a period of two years to deliver the Griffins program. Kim Symons was appointed to this role and has had an incredible first year of her appointment, leading the Griffins Squad into the opens environment. Thank you Kim for your passion and knowledge. We are lucky to have you leading a wonderful group of coaches, managers and primary carers who were all instrumental in a fantastic Griffins program and AMMNA Championships.

On behalf of the Committee I would also like to thank the ACT Government for their grant to allow us to run a planning day later this year. This will be an important milestone to develop our future focused strategic plan and priorities. Thank you to Netball ACT who continue to support our programs and in particular the growth of youth boys programs and the inclusion of male athletes into the ACTAS program. Thank you as well to Sandy, Erica and Tuggeranong Netball Association for their partnership to deliver a very successful youth boys come and try day and academy program. These have both been significant steps in growing youth boys pathways.

None of the significant achievements outlined above would be possible without the hard work of the entire ACTMMNA Committee. I want to thank each and every member of our fantastic Committee for their time, dedication and passion that has been poured into our programs over the last 12 months. In particular Nicole Crossley who will be finishing up in her role as Secretary at the upcoming AGM. We have been so lucky that you have shared your knowledge and experience with us and on behalf of the Committee a big thank you. If you are thinking about getting involved, I encourage you to put your hand up. In addition to official Committee roles there are smaller projects that we rely on our community to help deliver on. Lastly I would like to thank our Committee Members who will not be returning at the upcoming AGM, Nicole, Tom and Nathan. Thank you for your support, passion and energy you have put into the Committee. I am beyond grateful for the continued support of the whole Committee and our broader Netball community.



Thalia spoke to uniform pieces saying: "this design holds a special place in my heart right next to the love I have for the ACT Griffins program. I'm honoured to have been given the opportunity to design it and share my culture on a national scale. The meeting circles which connect along the sides of the jersey represent the different stages of our athletes and the moments that brought them to this high performance pathway. The ripple designs that run adjacent to them as well as on the sleeves, represent the influence the program has on our young people coming through Netball in the ACT as well as our impact on the wider ACT community who we represent at nationals."

"I wanted the griffs to have their own design to go along with the NACT bogong moth which I also designed. So even though it shares a similar style it belongs to the griffs family."

Junior Development

Academy Program

In addition to the ACT Griffins U17's team re-entering the AMMNA Championships, significant focus went towards growing our youth boys' programs. This included talent identification at local schools carnivals, targeted advertising and a youth boys program in partnership with TNA.



The TNA partnership was instrumental to the growth of our youth boys' pathways. This partnership resulted in a successful Come and Try Day held at the Tuggeranong Courts and a subsequent 8-week boys Academy. This was coached by Michael Catley with support from ACT Griffins athletes and head coach Kim. The program was a huge success increasing youth boys participation and building a pathway for boys to play netball.

Junior Representative Championships

As part of the annual Junior Championships held by Netball ACT, a youth boys division was included for the first time. This was built from a successful 3 match exhibition series in 2023. It was a historic step for boys' netball in Canberra and we thank Netball ACT for their support and growth of this pathway. The age group was 13-17 years, to support the introduction of the division. Two teams entered made up largely of players who participated in the 8-week academy program.



The success of the tournament was evident from the positive feedback of players and parents, community engagement and the smiles on all the players' faces. We look forward to continuing to work with Netball ACT to continue to develop the boys division.
